DIRECTION GIVEN UNDER ARTICLE 4(1)(b) TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1988

- 1. In this direction any reference to "article 3", "article 4" or "article 5" and to any paragraph thereof shall be a reference to article 3, 4 or 5 respectively of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 as amended by the Town and Country Planning General Development Order (Amendment) Order 1990 and the Town and Country Planning (Amendment) (No 2) Order 1990 (hereinafter called "the Order")
- 2. Nottingham City Council (hereinafter called "the Council") being the appropriate planning authority within the meaning or article 4 is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in the first schedule below should not be carried out within Wellington Terrace being the land and properties shown edged black on the plan annexed hereto and described in the second schedule hereto unless permission therefore is granted on an application.
- 3. The Council is further of the opinion that development of the descriptions set out in the first schedule hereto would be prejudicial to the proper planning of the area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of the area and that the provisions of article 5(4) should apply to this direction.
- 2. The Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by article 4(1)(b) HEREBY DIRECTS that the permission granted by article 3 and set out in schedule 1 hereto shall not apply to development of the land or buildings set out in the second schedule hereto.
- 3. The provisions of article 5(4) and 5(5) shall apply to this direction which shall remain in force until the 26th day of October one thousand nine hundred and ninety one (being six months from the date of this direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date.

construction maintenance improvement or alteration of a gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure); B (the formation laying out a construction of a means of access to a highway which is not a trunk road or a classified road, where that access in required in connection with development permitted by any class in Schedule 2 (other than part 2 Class A); and C (the painting of the exterior of any building or work)


