


## **CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND POLICE ACT 2001, SECTION 13(2)**

# NOTTINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (ARBORETUM AND RADFORD & PARK DPPO) ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES ORDER 2013

The Nottingham City Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 (in this Order called "the 2001 Act"), hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Land described in the Schedule below and shown on the plan attached to this Order (in this Order called "the Plan"), being land in the area of the City of Nottingham which is land to which the 2001 Act applies, is hereby designated for the purposes of the 2001 Act.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Nottingham City Council (Arboretum and Radford & Park) Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places Order 2013 and shall come into force on **12th August 2013**.
- 3. "Public Place" means any place to which the public or any section of the public has access on payment or otherwise, as of right or by virtue of express or implied permission.





#### SCHEDULE OF DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES

All publicly accessible places including, but not limited to, all highways, squares, pedestrian areas, public conveniences, doorways, entrances and other open areas within the boundary delineated by a thick black line on the Plan. These include those places described in Parts 1 to 5 to this Schedule but in the event of a conflict between the Plan and the Parts to this Schedule the Plan shall have precedence.






