

NOTTINGHAM CITY COUNCIL – NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2018

ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2015 – SECTION 10, 14, 15 AND 21 LOCAL AUDIT AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT 2014 – SECTION 25 - 28

The Council's accounts are subject to external audit by Tony Crawley for and on behalf of KPMG LLP of St Nicholas House, 31 Park Row, Nottingham NG1 6FQ. Members of the public and local government electors have certain rights in the audit process:

- 1. Notice is given that from 1 June 2018 to the 12 July 2018 (inclusive) between the hours of 9.00am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday any person may on reasonable notice inspect and make copies of the accounts of the Council for the year ended 31 March 2018 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) except as provided for in Section 26(4) to (26)6 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 in relation to commercially confidential and personal information. The accounts and other related documents will be available at the address given below. - 2. From 10am on 1 June 2018 to 4.30pm on 12 July 2018 (inclusive) a local government elector for Council's area, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the auditor at the address given above to make arrangements to ask any questions.

NOITCE is given that from 1 June 2018 to 12 July 2018 (inclusive) a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative may object to the Council's accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest (under section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014) and/or apply to the Court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 28 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to Laura Pattman at the address given below.

Please note that the accounts published for public rights of inspection are draft unaudited accounts and as such may be subject to change.
